2003 by staff members of Greenlights for Nonprofit
Success, a management support organization now known
as Mission Capital. From there, it's evolved and grown
into what it is today. Our mission is to provide accessible
professional development opportunities that empower
young leaders and advance the nonprofit community.

You can join at any time of the year! YNPN Austin Committees typically meet once per month for 1-2 hours. Committee business and action items also happen outside of meetings and we encourage you to join the YNPN Austin Slack Channel to get involved. There are no strings attached when you decide to attend a committee meeting. You have the opportunity to get involved in projects and action items as little or as much as you desire. You can "try out" one or all committees once, sample a few, or find a committee you feel passionate about and stick with it through the rest of the year to build your network and skills!

HOW TO GET INVOLVED



BOARD SERVICE

The YNPN Austin Board of Directors runs the day-to-day operations and oversees the governance of YNPN Austin. In this leadership role, Board Members learn how to lead a team, practice fiscal oversight, develop strategy and collaborate with peers across the organization. The YNPN Austin Board strives to be accessible and inclusive of everyone.

Our Board Positions vary in time commitment from 5 hours per month for some Vice Chair roles to 15 hours per month for our Executive Board Leader positions. We value flexibility and offer call-in options for internal meetings. Recruitment for Board Members takes place each year in the fall. Board term limits run from January – December. Executive Board and Chair positions are encouraged to stay for 2 years. Vice Chairs are a one-year term commitment.



Learn from the experts on professional development topics and enjoy free breakfast tacos and coffee.







COMPETENCY MODEL
















CODE OF CONDUCT & HARASSMENT POLICY
